Day 1 – Arrival in Tashkent

- **Meet at** Tashkent International Airport **and transfer to your hotel.**
- **Hotel check-in from 14:00.**

Free time. We recommend visiting:

- Magic City Park – **one of Tashkent's newest entertainment parks, famous for its evening atmosphere and spectacular musical fountains.**
- Seoul Mun Riverside – **a pleasant waterfront promenade, perfect for an evening walk, cafés, and relaxing after your flight.**

Overnight in Tashkent: Marwa Hotel* or similar.

Day 2 – Tashkent City Tour

10:00 – Guided sightseeing tour of Tashkent by private vehicle, including lunch.

Highlights include:

- Khast Imam Complex **and the Museum of Manuscripts, home to one of the world's oldest Qur'an manuscripts.**
- Chorsu Bazaar, **the city's iconic traditional market where local life comes alive.**
- Independence Square, **the symbolic heart of modern Uzbekistan.**
- Central Asian Plov Center, **where you will enjoy Uzbekistan's national dish.**
- Romanov Palace, **a beautiful reminder of the city's imperial past.**
- Amir Timur Square **and Broadway, combining elegant architecture with a lively pedestrian atmosphere.**
- Hotel Uzbekistan Observation Terrace, **offering panoramic views over central Tashkent.**

16:00 – Free time. We recommend visiting:

- Center of Islamic Civilization, **an impressive cultural and educational complex dedicated to the rich history of Islamic scholarship in Uzbekistan.**
- Sacred Heart of Jesus Roman Catholic Cathedral, **one of Tashkent's most beautiful examples of Gothic-inspired architecture.**

Overnight in Tashkent: Marwa Hotel* or similar.

Day 3 – Tashkent to Samarkand

10:00 – Private transfer to Samarkand by car.

14:00 – Arrival in Samarkand and hotel check-in.

The remainder of the day is at leisure.

We recommend visiting:

- **Registan Square in the evening, when its magnificent madrasahs are beautifully illuminated, creating one of the most memorable sights in Central Asia.**

Overnight in Samarkand: Shahrستان Boutique Hotel* or similar.

Day 4 – Samarkand City Tour

10:00 – Guided sightseeing tour of Samarkand by private minivan, including lunch.

Highlights include:

- **Gur-e-Amir Mausoleum, the final resting place of the great conqueror Amir Timur.**
- **Registan Square, the legendary architectural masterpiece of the Silk Road.**
- **Bibi-Khanyim Mosque, once among the largest mosques in the Islamic world.**
- **Shah-i-Zinda Memorial Complex, an extraordinary avenue of turquoise mausoleums and one of Uzbekistan's most sacred pilgrimage sites.**
- **Meros Paper Mill, where traditional handmade paper is still produced using centuries-old techniques.**

18:00 – Evening transfer back to Tashkent by private vehicle.

Overnight in Tashkent: Marwa Hotel* or similar.

Day 5 – Departure

- **Breakfast at the hotel.**
 - **Transfer to Tashkent International Airport for your departure flight.**
