Day 1 – Tashkent city tour

- **Pick-up at** Tashkent International Airport **and transfer to Hotel**

02:00 PM Start of the guided city tour by private minivan.

- Independence Square
- Plov Center (local cuisine experience)

Overnight stay in **Tashkent: Marwa hotel ***

Day 2 – Tashkent to Khiva City

Morning Flight from Tashkent to Urgench

Transfer to Tashkent International Airport

- **Pick-up at** Urgench International Airport and transfer to **Hotel Anor Qal'a**

10:00 AM, **Guided sightseeing of Khiva:**

- Kalta Minar Minaret
- Muhammad Amin Khan Madrasah
- Kunya Ark Citadel
- Tash-Khauli Palace
- Pakhlavan Mahmud Mausoleum
- Juma Mosque
- Islam Khoja Minaret
- Optional: **Khorezm flatbread-making workshop** (extra \$15 per person)

3:00 PM, Free time. We recommend visiting:

- **Nurillaboy Palace**, an elegant 19th-century residence featuring interactive exhibitions (entrance ~10 USD)

Overnight stay in **Khiva: Anor qal'a***

Day 3 – Khiva to Dashoguz (Turkmenistan)

- Drive to the **Uzbekistan–Turkmenistan border** and cross via **Shavat–Dashoguz** checkpoint
- Meet your Turkmen guide and driver, then drive to **Kunya Urgench**
- Sightseeing in Kunya Urgench:
 - Portal of Caravansaray
 - Mamun Minaret

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- Il Arslan Mausoleum
 - Sultan Tekesh Mausoleum
 - Academy of Khorezm
 - Kutlug Timur Minaret
 - Turabek Hanum Mausoleum
 - Nejemeddin Kubra and Sultan Ali Mausoleums
 - Lunch at a local café
 - Afternoon drive to **Darvaza Gas Crater**, known as “The Door to Hell” (70 m wide burning crater formed in 1971)
 - Watch the mesmerizing fire spectacle at sunset
 - **BBQ dinner**

Overnight stay in tents near the crater

Day 4 – Darvaza to Ashgabat

- **Picnic-style breakfast** at the camp
- Drive to **Gokdepe Horse Farm** (310 km, 4–5 hrs)
- Lunch in a cozy local café inside a traditional **yurt**
- Visit the **Gokdepe Fortress**, scene of the 1880 battle against Russian forces led by General Skobelev
- Explore the **Gokdepe Mosque**, notable for its turquoise domes and white marble architecture
- Visit the **Akhal-Teke Horse Farm**, home to over 30 of Turkmenistan’s legendary **Akhal-Teke horses** – a unique 5,000-year-old breed admired by rulers such as Alexander the Great and Darius I
- Drive to **Ashgabat**, check into the hotel

Afternoon tour around Ashgabat city

- Explore the “**Las Vegas of Central Asia**”:
 - Presidential Palace
 - Ruhyyet Palace
 - Wedding Palace (Palace of Happiness)
 - Modern “Yyldyz” Hotel
 - Constitution Monument
 - Arch of Neutrality

Overnight stay in **Ashgabat: Sport Hotel***

Day 5 – Ashgabat to Mary

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Drive to **Mary** (370 km, ~4 hrs) with a short stop at **Abiverd** to visit the ruins of the **Seyitjemaleddin Mosque**
- Continue to **Bayramali** (30 km) and explore the **State Historical Reserve “Ancient Merv”** – once called the “**Queen of the World**”, among the great Islamic capitals alongside Baghdad, Cairo, and Damascus

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- Learn about **11th–12th century Seljuk Merv**, a thriving metropolis covering over 640 hectares and attracting scholars and merchants from across the Islamic world
 - Hear about its tragic fall in **1221**, when Mongol forces destroyed the city and its monuments
 - Check into the hotel and rest

Overnight stay in **Mary: Mary Hotel***

Day 6 – Mary to Bukhara

- Breakfast and check-out from the hotel
- Drive to **Turkmenabat**, then continue to the **Farap–Alat border** via the bridge over the Amu Darya River
- Pass customs and cross into Uzbekistan
- Drive to **Bukhara** and check into **Emerald Hotel***
- **Dinner with folklore show** at **Nodir Devonbegi Madrasah** (7:00 PM)

Overnight stay in **Bukhara: Emerald Hotel***

Day 7 – Bukhara City Tour

10:00 AM, Guided sightseeing tour of **Bukhara**:

- Poi-Kalon Architectural Ensemble
- Miri-Arab Madrasah
- Ark Citadel
- Ulugh Beg Madrasah
- Abdulaziz Khan Madrasah
- Lyabi-Hauz Ensemble
- Trading Domes and Caravanserai
- Crafts Center

8:30 PM, Free time. Recommended visits:

- **Samanid Mausoleum** (9th century)
- **Shukhov Tower**

Overnight stay in **Bukhara: Emerald Hotel***

Day 8 – Bukhara – Gijduvan – Samarkand

10:00 AM, Drive to the **Summer Palace of the Emir of Bukhara**

12:00 PM, Transfer to **Gijduvan** to visit a family of hereditary ceramic masters

1:00 PM, Workshop tour and introduction to traditional pottery-making

3:00 PM, Drive to **Samarkand** (~3 hrs)

6:00 PM, Arrival and check-in at **Sharistan Art Hotel***

Evening free time, recommended visit:

- **Registan Square illuminated at night**

Overnight stay in **Samarkand: Shahrستان Art Boutique Hotel***

Day 9 – Samarkand City Tour

10:00 AM, Guided sightseeing by minivan:

- Gur-Emir Mausoleum
- Registan Square
- Bibi-Khanym Mosque
- Shakhi-Zinda Necropolis
- Authentic Paper Mill (using 8th-century techniques)

4:00 PM, Free time. Recommended visit:

- **Siab Bazaar**, for local crafts and dried fruits

Overnight stay in **Samarkand: Shahrستان Art Boutique Hotel***

Day 10 – Samarkand to Tashkent

- Morning Transfer to Tashkent
- Free time in Tashkent

Free time. Optional afternoon visits:

- Magic City Park with musical fountains
- Seoul Moon Riverside Promenade
- Roman Catholic Church of the Sacred Heart of Jesus
